OHCE Groups may enter one theme per exhibit. The exhibits shall be educational. Groups may select from the program areas: OHCE Promotional, Cultural Enrichment, Family Issues, Healthy Living, or Resource Management. Must be free standing with sides attached not to exceed 3' x 3' x 3' space. Contact the OSU Extension Center to reserve space for your exhibit. Ribbons will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th places. Placing for this class will not be included in the total group points. Criteria for judging will be: (1) effectiveness of the message, (2) appropriateness to the theme and (3) interest and attractiveness to the public.

Premiums will be paid by the Cleveland County Home & Community Education Association.

FOOD PRESERVATION

Must be canned in regulation canning jars (any size jar including Elite or Sharing) A jar showing spoilage or not sealed will not be considered when placing the entire exhibit. Make sure jars are clean on the outside. (NO COLORED JARS) All jars must be labeled with product name & canned date on lid. Must use Fresh Produce

VEGETABLES

- 901 One jar of tomatoes
- 902 One jar of tomato juice
- 903 One jar underground vegetables
- 904 One jar above ground vegetables
- 905 One jar of sauce-tomato, BBQ, etc.
- 906 One 1/4 to 1/2 pint filled jar dried herbs
- 907 One 1/4 to 1/2 pint filled jar dried vegetables

FRUITS

- 912 One jar juicy fruit (berries or cherries)
- 913 One jar fleshy fruit (pears, peaches, apples, apricots)

PICKLES AND RELISH

- 918 One jar dill cucumber pickles
- 919 One jar sweet pickles
- 920 One jar pickled, other (beets, asparagus, okra, etc.)
